Hello,

NSSA is recruiting quality referees for the 2024 World Skeet Championships, which will be held September 27 to October 5, 2024. Please note, this does add a day, Saturday, compared to the last few years. We want to provide the best for our World Championship participants, and you may be just who we are looking for.

While the schedule change adds a day, the end goal is to create a more spread out and comfortable workload. The Wayne Mayes Championship will be reverting to a shot event on Monday of the Main, but changes have been made to the 12 Gauge Main which will be shot on Tuesday and Wednesday. Specifically, the 12 Gauge is changing to a 200-target event where 4 rotations of 100 targets will be shot on Tuesday and Wednesday. While this change does add a day, the work days should be shorter in the long run and will result in a slightly larger payday because of the additional targets. Morning and evening hospitality will still be offered as a convenient and rewarding benefit for the hard work performed on the field. Lastly, we will shoot one rotation of 12 gauge on Friday of the Mini which will result in a slightly earlier finish on Sunday. This also spreads the workload of the demanding Mini World.

We are continuing to offer a great compensation package for the event.

Mini World - \$42.50 per flight – earn up to \$212.50 on Friday and Sunday and \$255 on Saturday

Main – Monday - \$42.50 per doubles and Wayne Mayes flight - earn up to \$255 for working 6 flights

Main – Tuesday – Saturday - \$42.50 per flight – earn \$170 for all four flights

In addition to competitive pay, NSSA will provide a hotel room, two per room, for those traveling from out of town. We need people that can work any or all of the event, but for full-time referees of the Mini and Main we provide an additional \$150 travel stipend. This stipend will be available regardless of the distance or mode of travel. Carpooling with you and three of your excellent referee friends would certainly purchase a lot of fuel.

For 2024, we have the early signup bonus program. Submit your World Shoot Referee Application on or before May 31 and receive \$100 early sign-up bonus added to your pay if you attend as indicated on your application. You must work a minimum of (3) full-time days to receive sign-up bonus. If May is too early to confirm your plans we are offering \$50 to anyone that submits their application prior to August 15. We hope this incentive will help make your decision to be a key contributor at the World Skeet Championships.

We have other options than full-time refereeing. These include refereeing the Mini and shooting the Main. The pay for the Mini would essentially offset your basic entry to shoot the Main. If your schedule limits your attendance for the full Mini and Main, we still want to hear from you! If you are up for the challenge, you can be a shooting referee, combining shooting and refereeing throughout all or portions of the event. Please let us know if one of these options works for you!

In summary, we know that our game requires people like you, and the World Championships deserves the very best. That is why we are looking for the best! I look forward to your positive response.
