The very first U.S. Open was also held in Zone I, at the beautiful Remington Gun Club in Lordship, CT. It is our goal to make the last as good as the first, so if there is anything we can do to help you enjoy your stay in Upstate New York, please just ask!

# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. All participants must be current members in good standing of NSSA. The shoot will be governed by NSSA rules and regulations.
- 2. JR and SJR shooters are permitted to compete on a "targets only" basis and do not pay NYSSSA daily fees. All competitors must present an up-to-date classification card.
- 3. Registration will be open Wednesday from Noon to 5:00 pm, Thursday from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm and Friday morning beginning at 8:30 am.
- 4. Squads will not be announced. Shooters are requested to be at the assigned field 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the flight. Management reserves the right to move slow squads to the practice field, unless the delay is caused by mechanical or weather problems.
- 5. Champions and Ladies awards will be presented on the main shoot off field immediately following completion of shoot offs. All other medals and awards will be available the following day, with the exception of 410 and HOA awards. All awards not picked up in person will be mailed within 15 business days.
- 6. All winners and payouts will be posted on the scoreboards the following day, except 410, HOA and HAA, which will be posted on the NSSA and Rochester-Brooks websites. All payouts will be mailed within 5 days of the shoot.
- 7. The protest committee will consist of shoot management and the NYSSSA Executive Committee members present.
- 8. Rochester-Brooks Gun Club reserves the right to alter or cancel any part of this program if conditions warrant. Shoot management also reserves the right to refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any contestant who annoys, endangers or interferes in any way with the harmony of the shoot.
- 9. Spectators and contestants assume all risks resulting from accident or loss of property occurring on gun club property. All contestants, referees and field personnel are required to wear eye and ear protection while on any shooting field. Spectators are likewise requested to wear eye protection at all times that shooting is taking place.
- 10. The club will be open for practice on Wednesday beginning at 9am and during the shoot whenever possible.
- 11. Breakfast and lunch will be served every day during the competition.

The "on-line registration tool" will go live on August 25 and the deadline for on-line registration is midnight Friday, Sept. 4, to allow sufficient time to process and email your confirmation prior to travel to Rochester.

As soon as your averages and classes are set prior to the shoot, visit <u>https://www.rbgunclub.com/us-open/</u> and "go through the line."

You will receive a confirmation by return e-mail which includes all the events you played, plus field assignments.

When you arrive at the club, skip the registration line and report directly to your fields, wait a day until the crowds die down, and then settle up with the cashier. RB accept VISA and Master Card.

Changes may be processed prior to the deadline, just go back through the on-line registration format, correct or update, and re-submit.

Orders for guest dinner tickets and Kolar Gun raffle tickets, payment for ammo and camping electricity can also be made during this process.
