GENERAL INFORMATION

FULL REFUNDS of \$100/\$150 deposit for cancellations will be granted through April 8.
***NEW:** All refunds will be assessed a 5% processing fee.
REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GRANTED DUE TO ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS.
REGISTRATION is open Wednesday 12-5PM; Thursday through Saturday 8AM-5PM; and Sunday 8AM-3PM.
TARGETS ONLY NOT AVAILABLE. SJ/JR/CL may elect to shoot for honors only in any event with purse amount being returned. Rookie/Novice concurrent is not offered at the Masters.
SHOOT-OFFS Event Champion, Runner-Up, Third, Class 1st-6th will be shot off. Also, Concurrent Champion, Runner-Up, Third, and Group 1 long-run ties will be shot off. Two and Five-man team places involving money will also be shot off. All orange targets will be used.
HOA CHAMPIONSHIP SHOOT-OFF will be conducted by doubles 3-4-5 miss and out by station.

Sunday:	HOA Champion (if necessary) followed by 410 bore, HOA & HAA


PRACTICE Member prices begin April 29th. All fields will be available for practice on Wednesday, Thursday - Sunday non competition fields will be available.
PROGRAM CHANGES
 Any part of this shoot program may be changed by Shoot Management. Notices of any change(s) will be posted at the Registration office. It is the shooter's responsibility to become aware of any change.
RULES, REGULATIONS & PROTESTS
 This shoot is registered by the NSSA and their rules will govern. All participants must have paid their current NSSA/NCSA dues before being allowed to compete in this tournament. There will be no exceptions. Squads will not be called. It is the shooter's responsibility to be at the correct field on time. Shooters missing their scheduled squad time run the risk of not completing the event. Shooters missing their squad will be allowed to join their squad in a subsequent round and finish the event by his or herself, provided—in the opinion of the referee—there is sufficient time before the next flight. If there is not time, they will be moved to the last flight of the day.
 Shoot management may refuse or cause withdrawal of any contestant who disrupts, endangers or interferes in any way with the harmony of the shoot or, in Management's opinion, whose conduct is unsportsmanlike. Unsportsmanlike conduct includes but is not limited to: falsifying scores or classification, cheating, verbal abuse, physical abuse of any shooter, scorer, field judge, shoot official or protest committee, and showing a pattern of begging for targets and calling for dead targets. All protests must be presented to the Protest Committee within thirty minutes after the flight is finished. The Protest Committee will consist of Shoot Management and representatives from the shoot. Protest Committee Ruling is final.

AWARDS / OPTIONS

SCTP(12 GAUGE ONLY): CH, RU AND 3RD

THERE IS A LIMIT OF FOUR CONCURRENTS PER SHOOTER

HIGH OVER ALL- ENTRY FEE: \$15 – All money returned to class. Payout same percentage as Main Event. CH, RU and 3rd comes out of class.

HIGH ALL AROUND- ENTRY FEE: \$15 – All money returned to class. Payout same percentage as Main Event.

CHAMP OF CHAMPS- ENTRY FEE: \$15 – total score of last round in each of the 4 guns. 1 class - ties divide.

OPTIONS/PURSES (available in all events)

OPTIONAL CLASS PURSE: \$10 each event – High Gun System, all money returned; ties divide.

OPTIONAL CONCURRENT PURSE: \$10 each event – High Gun System, all money returned; ties divide.

RED HOT: \$50 each event – open only – no classes – ties for high score divide.

OKLAHOMA OPTION (50'S): \$15 each event – high gun in class, ties divide.

TEAMS- Two-Man Open

ENTRY FEE: \$10 per person for two-man – Split 60/40, no medals – money only. Shoot-offs in teams for ties involving money.
