

Selection Process for NSSA Ray Boller Award Nominees

The NSSA Past Presidents Council has been given the responsibility of annually selecting a candidate for the Ray Boller Award. Nominees will be solicited from the membership by the NSSA Director of Skeet each year via the NSSA web site, *CLAY TARGET NATION* Magazine and *TARGETTALK* e-newsletter. A Nomination Form is posted on the NSSA web site which is to be used to submit candidates for consideration. Completed forms are to be submitted to the Director of Skeet at NSSA NDQ by November 30 for consideration for the following and subsequent years. In extenuating circumstances, a nominee may be considered out of cycle by the selection committee.

Nominations will be forwarded from HDQ to the Past President Council Chairman the first week of December for review and selection by the Committee. There will be one nominee per year selected by a majority vote of the PP Council and sent to the EC for their approval at their annual winter meeting. Candidates will remain under consideration for 7 years from the year of submission. If a nominee has not been selected after 7 years of consideration, that nomination will be dropped and the person who nominated the candidate will be notified of that action by HDQ.
