The Executive Committee will consider thoughtful, well-developed applications from any appropriate organization, program, club, or event seeking support.

Successful grant applications will demonstrate how their organization's efforts and specific programs will help achieve the three goals. Grantees will be required to **document and codify** program results in a meaningful way and **share their findings with the NSSA**. These metrics and results will play a critical role in assisting the NSSA in its ongoing outreach efforts to support women shooters.

The event(s) must be held at an NSSA Member Club. If you are not sure of the host club when submitting the application, please specify the State and provide the Club information once selected.

Grants will be reviewed by the NSSA Executive Committee and NSSA Assistant Director. If approved, grants will be awarded in an amount up to \$1,000. Grants funds will be distributed by NSSA annually in the form of reimbursement upon proper submission to NSSA of receipts, documentation and cooperative marketing media (i.e., photos, videos, and an event/program result summary).
