



NSSA AMBASSADOR CLUB PROGRAM

The NSSA Ambassador Club program is a new recognition program for member clubs that aims to acknowledge active clubs engaged in NSSA activities and programs. The ambassador club program has been designed with all clubs in mind regardless of the size of the club or the number of targets thrown. This approach gives all clubs an opportunity to be recognized if they meet the criteria of the program. There are no limitations on the number of clubs that will be recognized, and each club is eligible to receive an award annually. The program consists of four levels, determined by the number of completed activities:

- Platinum level – Complete all 7 items below in the year prior
- Gold level – Complete 6 of the 7 items below in the year prior
- Silver level – Complete 5 of the 7 items below in the year prior
- Bronze level – Complete 3 out of the 7 items below in the year prior

Awards

Clubs that take part in the program will be recognized for their involvement. The club will receive a plaque the first year they reach any of the four levels of the program as well as a token indicating their level of achievement. The token may be a coin, badge, emblem or similar item showcasing the specific level achieved. Each year any level of the program is reached, the club will receive their ambassador program token. This approach will allow clubs to display multiple years of achievement. In addition to the recognition plaque and tokens, clubs will receive rewards based on the level achieved as shown below.

- Platinum level – Free Club Membership, Free 5-Gun World Entry, and \$250
- Gold level – Free Club Membership, Free 5-Gun World Entry, and \$100
- Silver level – Free Club Membership and a Free 5-Gun World Entry
- Bronze level – Free Club Membership
