1. Database Update

2. NSSA State Grants

- Youth shooting events are moving forward at the NSC. Corporate events are still on hold at this time.
- Firehouse is 100% complete and is being outfitted.

5. Directors at Large Process Update

- Clark Hartness has put together documents that should be forwarded by the EC Committee to their BOD members for their feedback. Vote for implementation of this process for electing DAL should take place next week (June 9th).

6. Line of Credit Update

- We have been approved for the increase in the LOC. All details should be done within the next two weeks

7. I-Shoot Update

- Took place this past weekend at nine different clubs. Total of 114 shooters. Over 43,000 targets thrown. There were some new administrators that had not participated in an I-Shoot format previously and did not experience any real issues.
- Participants were from across all classes but the majority was from A, B and C classes.
- New Mexico held an I Shoot as well and positive feedback was received.
- Rebel Open is up to 70 shooters currently.

8. Forest City Gun Club/GA State Shoot Recap

- Georgia State shoot had over 100 participants (up from around 60 in 2019).
- Good feedback on the event and facilities.
