2021 MINI & WORLD Skeet Pay Rates

Referees will be paid by check

Mini/Main: *4 flights per day, plus daily shoot-offs – \$170.00 per day

Lunch will be provided each day of refereeing

- Hotel accommodations (2 per room)-non-local referees
- \$150.00 travel stipend for refs pulling full-time (Mini and Main)
- Free entry into the Referee Event
- \$10.00 per day fuel stipend for local referees
- Shoot Management may use Shooting Referees as needed to ensure that we have top quality referees.

***Pull over 4 flights – \$42.50 per additional flight**

***For 8 flights, the 12ga Main will be \$255.04 or \$31.88/flight**
